HARVEST NOTES

The 2005 vintage had perfect conditions for balanced viticulture as it followed the hard 2004 winter. The weather was near perfect in the Columbia Valley from bud break to harvest as there was a cool fruit set in June and intense sunshine with little rain during the ripening period. The vintage produced lower yields, leading to more concentrated small berries, with highly concentrated flavors. The 2005 Vintage will be remembered as one of the finest in Washington history.

WINEMAKER TASTING NOTES

Color: Deep Garnet

Aroma: Blackberry, blue fruit, cocoa, caramel/vanilla, cinnamon, nutmeg, and oak spice.

Flavor: Blackberry, currant, cassis, and lingering black pepper spices.
